



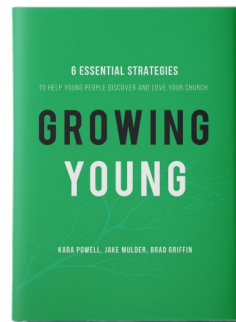
September 12 & 13, 2020
